### RECOMMENDATIONS FOR USE

FIRST CHOICE 2220 is a 100% water soluble product providing an easily diluted surface active agent. It is for use with Herbicides, Insecticides, Fungicides and Miticides as a spreading, depositing and sticking agent.

FIRST CHOICE 2220 recommended usage depends on the crop; the pest; the kind of spray equipment; volume, pressure and droplet size of the spray; the pesticide or mixture being used and water hardness conditions. Vary recommendations as necessary to achieve a smooth uniform film. Use only the minimum amount to get the desired effect.

### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Apply FIRST CHOICE 2220 for:

#### A. Dilute Full Volume Sprays:

- |                            |           |
|----------------------------|-----------|
| 1. Regular use             | 2-4 ozs.  |
| 2. Hard to wet plants      | 4-8 ozs.  |
| 3. Very hard to wet plants | 8-16 ozs. |

#### B. Concentrate Sprays:

As sprays are concentrated to 2x, 10x, etc. the amount of FIRST CHOICE 2220 should be increased in about the same proportion as the pesticide. The amount applied on a per acre basis should be the same as the rate in the dilute recommendation.

#### C. Aerial Sprays:

To improve pesticide coverage by aircraft, use ½ to 3 pints FIRST CHOICE 2220 per 100 gal of spray mixture.

FIRST CHOICE 2220 should be added to the spray mixture last, with the agitator running; after all other ingredients are well mixed.

### COMPATIBILITY

FIRST CHOICE 2220 is compatible and safe to use with nonselective herbicides, such as MSMA, Dowpon, Amino Triazole, Paraquat, etc. where a spray adjuvant is recommended to be used with such materials

### STORAGE & DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage and disposal.

**STORAGE:** Keep in original container. Do not reuse empty containers. Store in cool, dry place. Protect from excessive heat.

**PRODUCT DISPOSAL:** Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.
